



## **4<sup>th</sup> International Doctoral School in Urban Geopolitics: URBAN PERSPECTIVES ON THE RUSSIAN WAR IN UKRAINE**

### **Call for applications**

The University of Oslo, Taras Shevchenko National University of Kyiv and the City Institute (Lviv), in collaboration with partners of the Norwegian Research Council-funded UKRGEOPOL research project (<http://www.geokyiv.org/ukrgeopol>), are delighted to invite doctoral candidates to the **Urban Perspectives on the Russian War in Ukraine** Doctoral School to be held in Lviv, 9-12 October 2022.

The event will be held in English and Ukrainian. Sufficient knowledge of English is thus essential for participation.

The Doctoral School will provide an open and informal atmosphere for mutual exchange among both young scientists and senior researchers. The organizers hope to stimulate intense, productive, interdisciplinary and international dialogue and learning. A field trip to Sykhiv, the biggest housing estate in Lviv from the 1970-80s will be included.

The Doctoral School draws inspiration from the ongoing international research project *Ukrainian geopolitical fault-line cities: urban identities, geopolitics and urban policy*, funded by the Research Council of Norway. The event comprises a series of lectures, panel discussions (on "IDPs in the city" and "Life in the occupied cities") as well as a practical task. The practical task will explore topics related to post-war urban repopulation and reconstruction.
